COURSE OVERVIEW: Although human reason is forced to admit the existence of sin, it is utterly unable to account for its origin and its presence in human nature. It is vital for Christians to understand the principle factors that embody the doctrine of sin. In the lessons in this unit we hope to become well acquainted with the Biblical teachings concerning the doctrine of sin. Sin is a fact; but what is sin? Where did sin originate? How can we recognize sin? And who has sinned? Why do we act the way we do? The problem of sin is an enigma with which every system of thought must wrestle. Only the Bible, however, provides a reasonable and correct explanation to these questions. In this introductory lesson on sin, we will discover the answers to these questions.

COURSE LENGTH: 12 lecture hours/3.0 Quarter Credits

UNIT GOAL: To present the essential elements comprising a study of the doctrine of sin.

- 3. To list five characteristic which reveal the nature of sin.
